Races across North America and Europe have grown from only a handful of riders, to organizers having to put a cap on entry just to get it done before the weekend ends. The Fellowship of the Bearing, is shot in full High Definition and is like no other film out there. It’s the first production of its kind to take you into the lives of skaters that look at street hills as their stomping grounds. Rather than see intense “unskateable” roads as threats, longboarders have taken the initiative to show the world that hitting hills is an experience that’s worth giving a try. Addiction is inevitable.

Whether it is cruising with your bros near the beach, pre-drifting for switchbacks or blasting down hills at 60 mph, the Colabo Video is guaranteed to have you look at this rapidly growing sport in a unique and satisfying way.
